

# Law Day 2022 Illustration Contest

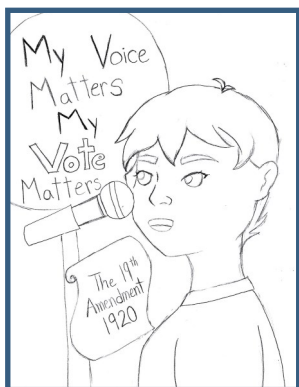

The Illustration Contest rules are:

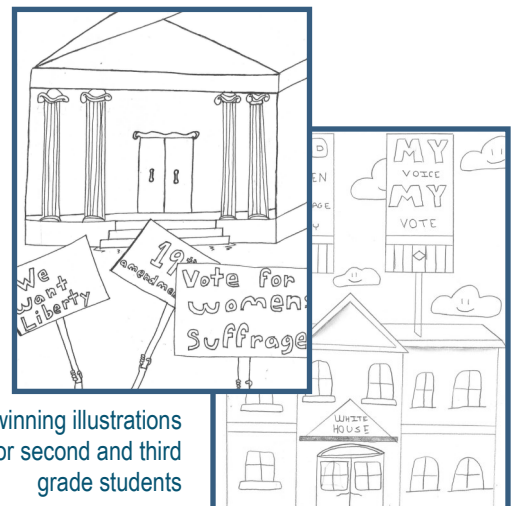
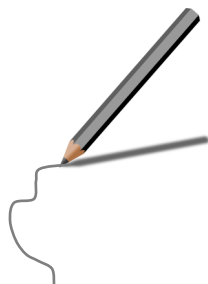
- ◆ The illustration must fit onto an 8½ x 11 sheet of paper and be in a format that can be colored.
