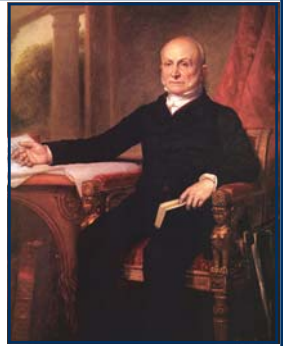

Essay Competition - Grades 7-8

Essay Competition Guidelines



1. **Who may enter:** Any student in grades 7 or 8 in a public, parochial or private school or anyone receiving home schooling.
2. The essay may be typed or legibly handwritten, with a limit of 500 words. The essay must be original and the exclusive work of the student.
3. The essay must represent our 2011 Law Day theme, **“John Adams, the First Lawyer President: He Stood for Adherence to the Rule of Law and Defense of the Rights of the Accused.”**
4. Judging will be based on content, clarity of expression and originality. Three finalists will be chosen from both grade levels.
5. Teachers/Instructors will be asked to judge the essays in their classrooms and mail the three finalists essays by the **deadline** date of **Monday, April 11, 2011** to:

6. Each essay submitted **should** contain the following information:
 - Printed name and signature of student;
 - Home address and telephone number;
 - School name and telephone number;
 - Teacher’s name and student’s grade level.

The student may request one of the following: have the essay posted without student’s or teacher’s name or name of school; or the first name of the student with teacher’s name and school; or the full names of the student, teacher and school.
