Poster Contest Guidelines



1. Who may enter: Any student in grades 4 through 6 enrolled in a public, parochial or private school or anyone receiving home schooling.
2. Poster may be on any type of paper. Size: No larger than 12 x 14. Picture may be illustrated either vertically or horizontally.
3. Illustration must be original and done freehand (cannot use computer) and the exclusive work of the student. Artwork may be done in school or at home.
4. Poster must represent our Law Day theme: **“John Adams, the First Lawyer President: He Stood for Adherence to the Rule of Law and Defense of the Rights of the Accused.”**
5. Only freehand lettering to be used (cannot use computer) - no stick-on letters. Ink, crayon, felt tip pens and/or paints are acceptable.
6. Teacher/instructor will be asked to judge the colored illustrations in his/her classroom and mail the three finalists pictures by **Monday, April 11, 2011** to:

Name of student
School, Grade level
Teacher/Instructor; Telephone number
Student’s home address and telephone number
