NINETEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT  
CIRCUIT COURT OF LAKE COUNTY

WHEREAS, pursuant to the general administrative authority of the Chief Judge of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit Court, Lake County, Illinois, set forth in the 1970 Illinois Constitution, Article 6, Section 7(c), and Illinois Supreme Court Rule 21(b), and

WHEREAS, the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit Court and our justice partners have developed eCourt, a new and efficient Integrated Case Management System known as eCourt, to replace CRIMS; and

WHEREAS, eCourt will become operational on October 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, to complete the data and document transfer from CRIMS to eCourt, the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit Court and the Office of the Circuit Clerk will need to modify operations on October 26, 2023.

IT IS ORDERED that the e-filing system, eFileIL, will be unavailable between October 26, 2023 at 5:00 p.m. and October 30, 2023 at 7:00 a.m. However, the Circuit Clerk will be able to accept any conventional paper filings which do not require a filing fee in-person during business hours at the Office of the Circuit Clerk on October 27, 2023.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time for the filing of all other documents required to be filed on or before October 26, 2023, through October 30, 2023, is extended to the next business day of the Court, October 30, 2023.
