IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

A. When documents are uploaded for filing and/or signature, the following documents/forms and document titles shall be used:

3. For Dismissal Order use: Dismissal Order (Form No. 401121P)
4. For Substitution of Judge Order use: Civil and Family Reassignment Order (Form No. 400146P)
5. For Mediation Referral Order use: Mediation Referral Order (Form No. 200204P)
6. For GAL/Child Representation Order use: Child Representation Order (Form No. 201084P)
7. For Expert Referral order use: Expert Referral Order (Form No. 201083P)
8. For Order of Contempt use: Order of Contempt (Form No. 200224P)
9. For Judgment of Dissolution use: Judgment of Dissolution (Form No. 100119P)
10. For Allocation Judgment use: Parenting Plan (Form No. 200141P)
11. For Notice for Withholding use: Notice of Withholding (Form No. 200201P)
12. For Uniform Order of Support use: Order of Support (Form No. 720103P)

13. For Order of Fees and Judgment use: Order of Fees and Judgment (Form No. 201103P)

B. Marital Settlement Agreement – When a Marital Settlement Agreement is incorporated into the Judgment of Dissolution, the Marital Settlement Agreement shall be uploaded as an attachment to the Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage.

C. When the following documents are e-filed, the document titles detailed below shall be used:

1. Parenting Class Certificate – Use the drop-down option for “Filing Code” of “Certificate” and type into “Filing Description” the following: Certificate Family Parenting Program.
2. UCCJEA Form – Use the drop-down option for “Filing Code” of “Declaration” and type into “Filing Description” the following: Declaration Under Uniform Child-Custody Jurisdiction And Enforcement Act.
