ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 24-23

NINETEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT  
COURT OF LAKE COUNTY

WHEREAS, on April 11, 2011, Administrative Order 11-12, incorporated herein, established a fee of \$10.00 per day for electronic monitoring of defendants sentenced to periodic imprisonment, unless after determining the inability to pay the court assesses a lower fee, appearing to be reasonable, and

WHEREAS, effective December 1, 2024, the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit will assume from the Lake County Sheriff's Office responsibility for the electronic monitoring program (see 730 ILCS 5/5-8A-1 et seq.).

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that defendants ordered to complete a term of electronic home monitoring shall make their initial payment pursuant to Exhibit B-EHM. If Defendant fails to make the initial payment, the Probation Department is directed to return the defendant to court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 10 business days of failure to make a biweekly payment to Sentinel, the Probation Department is directed to contact the Clerk of the Circuit Court to place the case before the assigned judge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Circuit Court shall place the case before the assigned judge on that judge's next motion date, unless the Court directs otherwise.
