**Additional conditions of Probation/Supervised Supervision
ELECTRONIC HOME MONITORING (EHM)**

Defendant has been sentenced to a term of probation or supervised supervision and ordered to a term of Electronic Home Monitoring (EHM) as supervised by the Adult Probation Services Division of the 19th Judicial Circuit. Defendant is therefore subject to and **MUST** follow as well as comply with these additional conditions and requirements:

- A. Defendant must have a valid address in Lake County, IL and have a working phone number. Defendant may not reside in a basement area/bedroom where the EHM/GPS device cannot work properly due to signal interference.
- B. Defendant must obtain **prior approval** of supervising probation officer prior to any changes to home address, telephone number, or employment status.
- C. Defendant shall be permitted to leave for verified employment, seeking employment, undergoing medical, psychiatric counseling, or other treatment, probation obligations, attending school, religious services, meetings with attorney, and purchasing food or other basic needs. All permitted outings **must be pre-approved by Probation Supervision unless it is a medical emergency or otherwise ordered by the Court**. Defendant must go directly to the scheduled event and return to their residence immediately upon completion.
- D. Defendant must wear the Electronic Monitoring device(s) 24 hours a day seven days a week and not remove this device(s) from my person without Court authorization. Defendant shall not tamper with any of the Electronic Monitoring equipment and must report any loss or damage immediately to their Probation Supervision Officer. Any attempt to tamper with the equipment, allow the battery to discharge or cause a malfunction of the equipment will result in notification to court.
- E. Defendant must comply with all procedures set forth by Sentinel staff regarding the care, maintenance, use, and charging schedule of the device.
- F. Defendant agrees to make a payment of \$190.00 at the time of installation of the EHM device (\$50.00 for installation and \$140.00 for the first two weeks of service). After the first two weeks, Defendant agrees to pay \$10.00 per day shall be paid biweekly to Sentinel. Payment can be made by money order, cashier's check or credit card. Willful failure to pay the agreed upon costs biweekly is violation of probation or supervised supervision that may result in a revocation.
