ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 25-01

NINETEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT
COURT OF LAKE COUNTY

WHEREAS, Public Act 103-0789, effective January 1, 2025, requires that all Illinois Citation and Complaint Forms include an admonishment that a defendant's failure to appear in court may lead to significant consequences impacting the violator's driving privileges,


WHEREAS, in compliance with these new requirements under 625 ILCS 5/6-308, the Notice to Appear section on the Illinois Uniform Citation and Complaint Form has been updated thus requiring all agencies to update their electronic citation programs to comply with the new standards, and

WHEREAS, this Court acknowledges that these changes require law enforcement agencies to update their electronic citation programs and/or to procure new paper citation forms, thereby posing logistical challenges for many law enforcement agencies.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that law enforcement agencies within the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit are granted a 90-day extension and shall implement the statutory changes by April 1, 2025.
